

Dear Praying Friends,

January 12, 2010 was a day that not only changed the lives of many Haitians, but it was a day of change for us as well.

First of all, it has changed our *Mindset*. God's grace and protection was so evident in our lives that day. We now take life one day at a time here, always remembering that only sixty miles away from us there are people who lost everything, and we are ever mindful that had it not been for God's grace, we could have lost everything as well.

Secondly, it has changed our *Ministry*. God has sent us almost 575 refugees who are related to people in the seven churches planted by us and the Bowers. We are providing food and other things needed by these people who have nothing. We have enrolled over thirty four refugee children in our three schools (tuition free) and have provided them with books and supplies. Harry and Tim also took a four day trip to Fouchè with a team of Haitian and American pastors and evangelists. They distributed tents and held three days of evangelistic services. Thirteen people accepted the Lord during this campaign. In the next few months we have plans to continue to minister to the refugees here by providing food and distributing other items designated for earthquake victims.

Thirdly, it has changed our *Mission Field*. All over Haiti, we are seeing the fires of revival sparking. Fre Alin's mother-in-law lost a child in the earthquake. She came here to live with her family. Harry went to look at the cuts on her legs and had the opportunity to witness to her; she accepted the Lord. She stood and gave the following testimony in church:

"I was trapped in the building, yelling for someone to help me, but no one came. If you are here without Christ and trusting in something else to save you, you are just like I was - trapped. You are yelling for someone to help you, but nothing except Jesus can."

Haiti is known as an island dedicated to Satan, but just four days before the Satanic celebration of Mardi Gras, the government called for two days of nation-wide prayer and fasting, and the celebration of Mardi Gras was cancelled. Praise God, that because of the destruction, people are turning away from the prince of this world to the true Prince of Peace, Jesus Christ.

Please continue to pray for us as we do what we can to further the gospel here whether it is through preaching, teaching, or distributing food.
