*Zanmi Mwen is a Haitian Creole word which means "my friend." Through the Zanmi Mwen child sponsorship program, you can*

*make a Haitian child your friend by financially sponsoring his/her education for the year. Your one time gift will pay to give a Haitian child a Christian education for the entire school year including tuition, books, uniforms, and school supplies. You will receive regular updates all throughout the school year as to the progress your friend is making.*



## Changing Haiti . . .

*Children in Haiti have little hope. Haiti is the second poorest country in the world, and no free public education exists in Haiti. In order to attend school, parents*



*must pay for tuition, books, uniforms, and supplies. Many times children cannot attend school because their par-*

*ents cannot afford to send them. Therefore, the literacy rate in Haiti is less than 20%.*

*During our past four years as missionaries in Haiti, we have seen the need for sound Christian education, not only to give children a quality education, but also to counteract the Satanic philosophies the children are being taught in the public schools. It is our goal as missionaries to use Christian education to give Haitian children hope for the future.*
