

Dear Praying Friends,

During my recent trip to Haiti in October, the Lord revived my heart anew for our ministry in Haiti. Philippians 1:6 says, "Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ." As I returned home with stories from Haitian friends and goodies for our children from Haiti, the Lord gave us a desire to be **BACK HOME IN HAITI**. It is with this desire that we will begin the process now for our return in June.

My **TRIP HOME** in October was very successful. I want to thank you for your prayers for safety and the continued prayers for the protection of our home. I found our home in good shape with many things still in good working order. I was able to get school started for the new year and enroll students in our Zanmi Mwen Child Sponsorship Program. I also talked with both of our national pastors, and both church plants are going well. I praise the Lord for these faithful Haitian men.

In December, my family and I plan to spend **CHRISTMAS AT HOME** in Haiti for several reasons. First of all, in October I was unable to take in several hundred pencil boxes filled with school supplies that were donated for the schools due to lack of space and lack of funds for customs. Because they paved the road between Pignon and St. Raphael and built a bridge, we are now flying in to Pignon instead of Cap Haitian. This means only a 30-minute (and much safer) drive on a paved road to get home, but it also means paying more in customs and more difficulty in arranging to get cargo flown in to us. We plan to take these pencil boxes in as Christmas gifts in December. Secondly, we are returning in December to take inventory of the things we need and the things that need to be repaired so that we will know what to buy and what to bring in with us in June.

Melissa, Bethany, and I plan to **RETURN HOME** to Haiti in June. Because of the devaluation of the gourde and the change in airports, we have some very specific needs. First of all, if your church would like to help with the cost of our December trip or the cost of the customs on the pencil boxes as a special Christmas project, that would be a tremendous blessing to our family. Secondly, after our trip, we will have a list of some very specific things that we will need to take back with us in June. If you would like to help with the purchase of these items, please contact me. Third, we do need to raise some additional support and will be traveling on the weekends visiting churches. If your church would like for us to come and visit, please send me an email.

Lastly and most importantly, we need your prayers. We praise the Lord for faithful men who have maintained the ministries in our absence, but we are looking forward to getting **HOME TO GROW THE MINISTRIES**. Satan would like for our ministry to remain the same, but we are ready to **GET HOME** to fulfill the vision for Haiti that the Lord gave us in 2006. Thank you again for your prayers and support for our family.
