It is exciting to be back in “missionary mode,” traveling to supporting churches and preparing for our return trip to Haiti at the end of the summer. These past few weeks have been busy visiting with supporters and gathering and boxing up supplies to take back to Haiti with us. One of the questions that we get asked most often is, “Are you excited to get back to Haiti?” Our reply is always, “Yes!” After our reply, we often get something which sounds like this statement – “I could never do what you do. Why would you pack up everything and go to Haiti?”

We have been thinking about this question a lot lately. Why leave everything and go to Haiti? It can all be summed up in one word: **VALUE**. The Bible says in Matthew 6:21, “For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” This verse means that we will love the things that we value most. God also values our talents. Over the past couple of years, our goal has been to use the talents the Lord has given us to minister for Him in the most effective way possible. Please pray that we will continue to do so over the next few months. Also pray that the Lord will clearly show us new ministries that He is opening up for us in Haiti so that we can prepare supplies and materials in advance.

Most importantly, God places the utmost value on souls. Throughout the years that we have been in Haiti, our ministry has tried to concentrate on the individual. We have not seen dramatic changes in whole villages or schools, but we have seen individuals who have come to know Christ and their lives have been impacted for the Gospel. For example, we witnessed to Pastor Ronald’s mom, the wife of a witch doctor, for many years. She was always pleasant, but she never would accept Christ. However, one Sunday, when we ordained Pastor Ronald, she came to church, and several Sundays later, she was saved. Now three years later, she is still faithfully serving Christ and singing in the church choir. God places great value on the souls of men, and so should we! Pray that we would never forget this truth.

Throughout the years, your prayers and support have been invaluable to our family. Only God knows how many times your prayers and/or financial support have helped to meet a specific need of which you knew nothing about. Or how many times your prayers have granted safety and sent in legions of angels to war on our behalf. ***You are a valuable part of our ministry, and we appreciate you!***
